

# WHAT DOES A GOOD CANDIDATE LOOK LIKE

## Globally and regionally mobile

Dependant on the programme

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## Work experience / international experience

Previous relevant work experience or international experience preferred

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## Activities/interests

Several areas of interest and leadership level of achievement. (E.g. Sports, societies, committees, organising a significant event or trip, professional membership, languages, charity/voluntary work)

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## Career ambition

Clear motivation for the programme they have applied for and why they have applied to Rolls-Royce

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## Language

Fluent in the English language required. Other languages highly desirable

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# WHAT DOES A GOOD CV LOOK LIKE

## What is a CV?

It is a summary of yourself, not only of just what you have done  
Engage the reader and sell yourself

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## What to include in a CV?

Structured in section with a common theme

- **Personal information**, right at the top of the page
  - **Professional profile**, few line to engage and convince the reader that you are the right candidate for the job
  - **Professional experience and skills**
  - **Education**, include grades (achieved or expected)
  - **Extra-curricular activities and achievements**
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## What NOT to include in a CV?

- NO Cover Letter, instead use the professional profile to engage the reader.
  - NO tables and NO standard layout (i.e. NO europass)
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## Hints & tips

Use positive language and do not exceed 2 A4 pages  
Spell check and ask a friend fluent in English to review

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
